SPECIFICATION FOR RICE BRAN (RAW)

Guarantee

Sand/silica	: 2.5% (Max)
Moisture	: 10.0% (Max.)
Husk	: 3.0% (Max.)
Crude Fat/Oil	: 16.0% (Min.)

Terms for rebate and premium :

- 1 For decrease in crude Fat rebate will be @ 3.33% per unit upto 14% of fat. Thereafter deduction will be made @ 6.25% per unit upto 12% crude fat. Goods are liable for rejection if crude fat (Oil/EE) is found less than 12%.
- 2 Deduction will be made @ 1% per unit if silica is found more than 2.5% but upto 5%. Thereafter deduction will be made @ 2% per unit upto 8% silica. Goods are liable for rejection if silica is found more than 8%.
- 3 For increase in moisture, rebate will be @ 1% per unit upto 13%. Goods are liable for rejection, if moisture is found above 13%.
- 4 For husk percentage exceeding 3% but upto 5% rebate will be @ 1% per unit. Therefore, deduction will be made @ 2% per unit upto 8% husk. For husk percentage exceeding 8% material is liable for rejection.

Premium conditions:

1. Premium will be made @ 1% per unit, if fat content found in goods is more than 16% upto 20%.
2. Premium will be made @ 1% per unit, if sand silica content found in goods is less than 2.5%.

Other terms and conditions :

1. Guarantee/ rebate norms is on as such basis.
2. Old stock and material treated abnormally are liable for outright rejection during inspection of material.
3. Material should be fresh and free from lumps, moulds, fungi, rancidity and abnormal flavor.

- (i) For increase in dust above 1% and upto 2% rebate will be @ 1% per unit. Thereafter deduction will be made @2% per unit upto 3% dust. Goods having more than 3% of dust are liable for rejection.
- (ii) For increase in foreign matter upto 3% rebate will be @ 1% per unit. Goods having more than 3% of foreign matter are liable for rejection..
- (iii) Moisture is acceptable upto 15% with rebate @ 1% per unit. Goods are liable for rejection, if moisture is foun above 15%.
- (iv) For increase in damaged grained/ infestation upto 5% rebate will be @ 1% per unit. Thereafter deduction will be made @ 2% per unit upto 10% and deduction @3% will be made for damaged grained / infestation upto 15%. Goods having more than 15% of damaged grained/ infestation are liable for rejection.

Rebate & Premium Terms:

- (i) For increase in Moisture rebate @1% per unit upto 12%. Goods are liable for rejection, if moisture is found above 12%.
- (ii) For increase in fibre rebate @ 1% per unit upto 8% of fibre. Rebate will be 2% per unit for fibre upto 10%. Goods above 10% fibre are liable for rejection.
- (iii) For decrease in crude protein per unit rebate will be @ 1.0% per unit below 41% upto 40% of crude protein and further deduction @2.0% per unit upto 38% of crude protein. Goods found less than 38% crude protein are liable for rejection.
- (iv) For increase in silica rebate @ 1% per unit upto 3% silica. Goods are liable for rejection, if silica is above 3%.
- (v) For decrease in fat below 4.0% upto 3% rebate @ 1% per unit will be effective. Further deduction @ 2% for Fat upto 1%. The item containing Fat below 1% is liable for rejection.

General terms & conditions :

1. The above Guarantee is on as such basis.
2. Material should be fresh and free from moulds, fungi, rancidity, abnormal flavor and over burnt and other adulterant including NPN/Urea.
3. Old stock and material treated abnormally roasted / toasted are liable for outright rejection during physical inspection of material.
4. Moisture report of Laboratory of CFP during receipt, would be final and binding to the supplier.

DETAILED TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER DOCUMENT

1. Brokers shall indicate the name and address of the supplier of raw materials and this shall be accompanied with sample of materials. Brokerage will be paid @Rs.10.00 (Rupees Ten) only per MT or 1% of the cost of the ordered, supplied quantity whichever is less.
2. The rates quoted by concerned suppliers shall be valid at least upto _____ And they will have to supply the material at the quoted rate as per ordered specification and as per the delivery schedule stipulated in the Purchase Order.
3. Parties may send free samples of the above items as per our specification along with the offer.
4. Rates shall be quoted on F.O.R. Cattle Feed Plant and on gross weight basis as per enclosed format for different raw materials. For molasses/ Rub Gur and Vitamins premix, net weight would be considered.
5. Bidder submitting the rate for less than 50% of the tendered quantity of materials shall not be considered.
6. The new tenderers must indicate their GST, PAN Registration Nos. in the offer, failing which the offer of the party will be summarily rejected. Applicable taxes (if any) must be specifically indicated in the offer even if the net offered rate is tax paid. All statutory liability of taxes, duties shall be of the suppliers and shall be borne by them within the rate offered.
7. The quantity required as mentioned in Annexure I may be changed based on availability of raw materials and its rate.
8. COMFED/ Unions/ Units at its sole discretion may distribute the order quantity to more than one supplier without assigning any reason to any of the successful bidder during issuance of order after discussion with relevant eligible suppliers.

The splitting of the tender/ Purchase quantity will be made on the following manner.

L1 bidder : 70% of the ordered quantity.
L2 bidder : 30% of the ordered quantity.

However, if the L1 bidder quoted the rate for restricted quantity, then COMFED/ Unions / Units may distribute the rest quantity t L2 or L3 bidder based on L1 rate.

9.The excess/ less quantity upto +-10% or maximum one truck load whichever is less shall be acceptable. But such relaxation would be under full discretion of Purchase only.

10.Our payment terms shall be 75% within ten days of receipt of materials alongwith invoice and on physical verification and balance 25% on receipt of test report. All payment will be made from concerned Cattle Feed Plants.

11. The weighment of material shall be carried out at Cattle Feed Plant or as arranged by the Purchaser. The weight of the materials so received will be treated as final and binding to the suppliers.

12. Material to be suitably packed to prevent damages or any pilferages during transit. The goods packed in torn or unsound condition of bags may be rejected or may face proportionate deduction.

13.The materials to be delivered strictly as per prescribed specification. In case of deviation, VPMU reserves full right either to accept the goods after imposing additional rebate beyond acceptable guidelines in accordance to the consent of suppliers or issue directive to the supplier to lift the rejected goods after intimation either through letter / mail or telephonic intimation too. In carrying out above task or either rejection or accepting the commodity with additional rebate, this should not demand any clarification or explanation from the supplier in subsequent period and the decision on above exercise adopted by VPMU would be final and binding to the supplier. Beyond the stipulated lifting time limit of 15 days from information to lift the materials, the rejected goods would be disposed of as per discretion of VPMU and no correspondence on same would be entertained. The cost of disposal would be recovered from the supplier account. Payments are likely to be held up if quality of the materials found to be substandard.

14. Late delivery penalty: VPMU will have full discretion to receive the item and honour the order beyond the schedule date of delivery subject to prior approval from the Purchaser. In case the material is accepted after schedule date, the penalty will be imposed @1% of the total supply value for first 15 days and 2% upto 30 days the due delivery date. The delivery of items beyond that needs further approval from Purchaser only.

15.COMFED/Union/Units reserves the right to purchase the materials at the risk cost and responsibility of the supplier in case of non-supplies or short supplies. All expenses including payment in risk purchase shall be adjusted against the security deposit or shall be recovered from the pending bills of the supplier. Alternatively, it shall be recovered from the through legal action also.

16.comfed/Union/Units reserves the right to reject any or all the offers without assigning any reason thereof. In the event of any dispute between the parties, both the parties mutually resolve such disputes, failure of which, such dispute shall be referred to arbitrator to be appointed in accordance with the provisions of Indian Arbitration Act, 1996. The Arbitration proceeding will have to be held at Patna or such other place as decided by the Arbitrator at his discretion. The order/ decision of arbitrator shall be final and will be accepted by both the parties.
